

**EMERGENCY ORDER REGARDING THE  
PROVE-UP OF UNCONTESTED DIVORCES, SAPCR's  
MODIFICATIONS AND NAME CHANGES**

This ORDER, pursuant to Section 22.035(b) of the Texas Government Code as directed by the Supreme Court of the State of Texas, is hereby entered by the 306<sup>th</sup> District Court, and County Court at Law Numbers One, Two and Three.

From this date forward, until further noticed by the courts, all agreed and uncontested matters ordinarily presented by live testimony in Galveston County courts **shall** be presented by affidavit of testimony.

Attorneys are ORDERED efile the proposed orders with all necessary supporting documents along with the AFFIDAVIT OF FACTS.

The courts will review the proposed, signed orders and affidavit without the necessity of a live appearance in court.

The Court will contact the attorneys if there are any issues approving the order.




